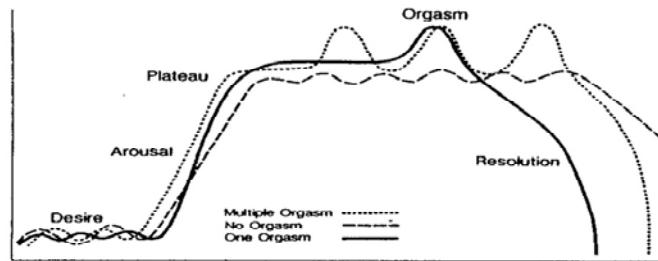


## Classic Human Sexual Response Cycle

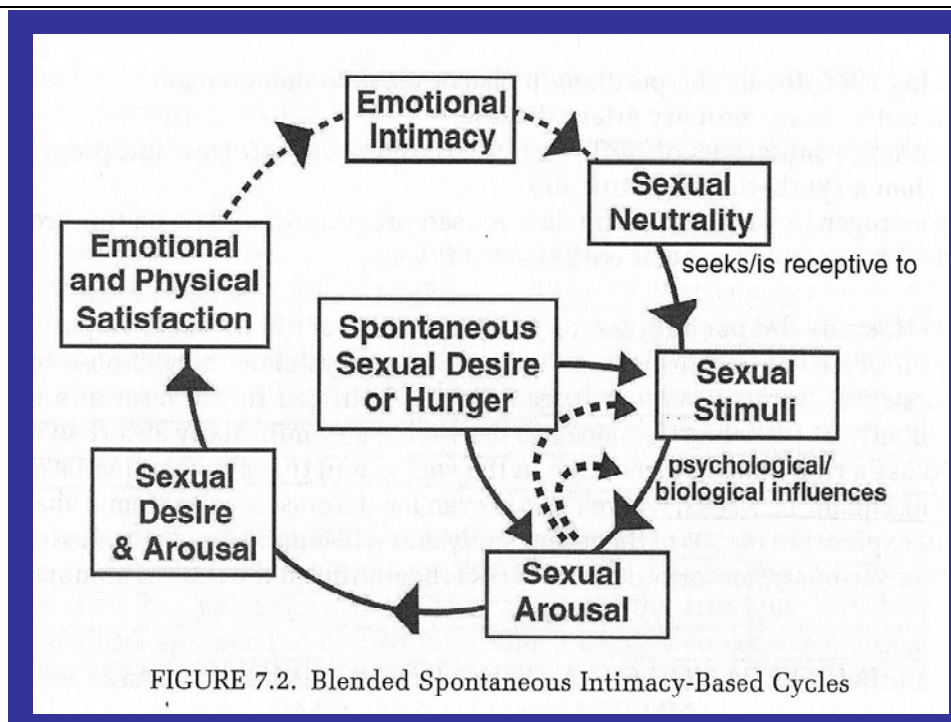


FIGURE 7.2. Blended Spontaneous Intimacy-Based Cycles
